	regardless of make or miss.
Player fouls	A player is allowed 5 fouls. On the 5 th foul they are fouled out.

Team fouls	On the 5 th team foul, the offensive team is awarded free throws.
Tourn Tourn	***The 1- or 2-point free throw rule applies.

	***There is no "Make-it Take-it" rule. The scoring team does not retain possession.
	***There is no "Check it" rule after a made basket. Play does not stop for both
	teams to become set.
Dead ball	The ball must be "checked" so both teams are ready. The ball must be passed in
	from out of bounds from the top.
	***Checking the ball: The offensive player stands out of bound and passes to the

	defensive player guarding him and says "check". The defensive player passes the ball back to the offensive player and says "ball in".
Jump ball	Jump ball will go to the defense. It is considered a dead ball and play will resume by following the dead ball rules.
Substitutions	A sub can enter during a dead ball. The sub needs to enter before the ball is checked.
Basketball rules	Games will be officiated per IHSAA rules that apply.
Basketball goals and backboards	Anytime the ball or player touches any part of the basketball goal, they are considered out of bounds. Also, the top of the backboard is out of bounds. The sides and bottom of the backboard are in-bounds.
Weather policy	Adverse weather conditions and unplayable conditions may result in the following: Games may be delayed, or the points required to win a game may be reduced. The tournament format may be changed from double elimination to single elimination or other steps may be taken. In the unlikely event of cancellation of the tournament due to adverse weather conditions, each team shall receive their team registration package. Under no circumstances will a team receive a full cash refund of the entry fee.
Unsportsmanlike behavior	FFF reserves the right to eject players, teams, and/or fans from games or entire tournament for any misconduct during the event.
