## SKILLS CONTESTS ARE LOCATED AT THE FOLLOWING HOLES:

Closest to the Pin - Men #1 and Women #6

Longest Drive - Men #7 and Women #13 (Drive must be in fairway)

Longest Putt - Men and Women - one winner - #18

GOLF SCRAMBLE RULES: (all golf rules shall conform to USGA Rules)

FORMAT: Four person scramble tournament.

## GOLF ETIQUETTE:

1. Please smooth all marks made in Sand Bunkers.
2. Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out. Mark your scorecard on the next tee.
3. Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range.
4. Please repair all ball marks on the greens prior to putting.
5. Please observe all local course rules.
6. Enjoy the day and your fellowship with other golfers!

## RULES:

1. A scramble means that all team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
2. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the marked spot.
3. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
4. This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green also and putts need to be made within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole).
5. Bogey is your Friend! To improve the pace of the play, once your team reaches Bogey, pick up and move to the next hole. Record Bogey as your score.
6. Men under age 65 tee off from the white tees and men 65 and over and women from the red tees.
